Southwell Leisure Centre

Introduction

Services/Facilities within the building include a fitness suite, sports hall, social hall, 2 swimming pools and squash courts

Location

The venue is situated at the end of Southwell Town There is a continuous unobstructed access route from Nottingham Road There are bus stops within 10m of the venue



Parking

Parking is free for all users. The car park is located at the front and to the right of the building The car park type is open air/surface Parking spaces for Blue Badge holders do not need to be book in advance. There are 3 Blue Badge spaces within the car park These spaces are 25m from the main entrance The route from the car park to the entrance is accessible to a wheelchair user. The car park surface is tarmac There is a dropped kerb between the car park and the venue



Reception

The reception is in sight of the entrance and identifiable The reception desk is 3000mm wide and 1200mm high The reception area is split into 2 areas, a viewing area and the reception area, there is a screen separating these areas



Inside Access

There is level access to the sports hall and swimming pools, other facilities are located on the ground floor, these are social hall and squash courts. The fitness suite is on the 2nd floor.

There is not a hearing assistance system

The venue does play background music

Music is played in the fitness suite

Motorised scooters are allowed in public parts of the venue

The lighting levels are varied

Pool Access

We have 2 swimming pools on the ground floor Our main pool is 4 land, 25m in length Our teaching pool is 12m x 7m Entry to both pools is via fixed stairs into the pool Both pools also have hoists to aid access to both pools There is a viewing area next to the teaching pool.



Other floors

The first Floor can be accessed by stairs or the lift The steps have uniform risers and treads of equal depth and width There are 7 steps to the platform, then 7 more to reach the fitness suite. There is a set of stairs to the treatment room, 6 steps to the first platform then 6 more to the top There are hand rails to both side of the stairs at above line pitch.



Lift

There is a lift for public use The lift is located on the left side of the sports hall The lift is an Ambassador Lift The floors which are accessible by this lift are the ground to first floor Staff do not need to be notified for use of the lift The clear door width is 995mm The Dimensions of the lift are 1100mm x 1400mm There is a support rail provided on the right looking into the lift, at 900mm high The controls for the lift are 900mm high from the floor The lighting level in the lift is high



Fitness Suite

The fitness suite is located on the first floor Level access is by lift or stairs The fitness suite is broken into 3 areas All Staff receive basic disability awareness training A portable hearing loop is not available for induction There is clear manoeuvring space between equipment There is level access to all equipment



Accessible Toilets

We have 5 accessible toilets on the ground floor throughout the venue The toilets are not for the sole use of disabled people There is one sited near the viewing area in the reception area There is one in the male and female changing rooms There is one sited in the Squash court area There is one in the viewing area of the teaching pool There are pictorial signs on the doors A radar key is needed to access them Lights are activated automatically The dimensions of the toilets range between 2250mm x 2500mm There are mix of left and right transfer toilets There are mixer taps There are emergency cords in each toilet Disposable facilities are available in the cubicle There are female sanitary and non-infectious waste disposal units



Accessible Changing Area There is an accessible changing area, which is accessed from both the male and female changing rooms Access is by radar key The room is 1700mm x 2000mm in size Doors open outward at both sides There is a portable hoist, changing bed and pool chair Lights are activated automatically

Lockers are access outside the changing area

All staff receive disability awareness / equality training Documents can be requested in large print A bowl of water can be provided for an assistance dog A member of staff trained in BSL skills in not normally on duty
