Access

Dukeries Leisure Centre -

Introduction

Services / facilities within the building include a sports hall, fitness suite, studio, and an activity room.

Location

The venue is situated Broughton, on the outskirts of New Ollerton

There is a continuous unobstructed access route from Main Road and well signposted from Tuxford Road and on Main Road

There are 2 bus stops, opposite the entrance, there is a driveway leading to the centre

Parking

Parking is free for all users.

The car park is located at the side of the facility

The car park type is open air/surface.

Parking spaces for Blue Badge holders do not need to be booked in advance.

There are 2 Blue Badge parking bays at the front of the facility.

The nearest Blue Badge bay is 10m from the main entrance.

The route from the car park to the entrance is accessible to a wheelchair user

The car park surface is tarmac.

Main Entrance

The entrance has two sets of accessible automatic doors, each door panel have the Active 4 today logo on them.

Reception

The reception is in sight of the entrance and identifiable

The reception desk is 900mm high, with a wheelchair accessible desk 750mm high

The main area is very spacious and good lighting





Inside Access

There are 3 levels, reception on level 1, access to the fitness suite is via a lift and stairs and is on level 3 Accessible changing facilities are on Level 2.

Other facilities are located on level 2. These are a sports hall, studio and activity room and an accessible toilets/shower There is not a hearing assistance system.

Music is played in the fitness suite.

Motorised scooters are allowed in public parts of the venue.

The lighting levels are varied.

Other Floors

Level 2 can be accessed by the stairs or the lift.

The steps have uniform height risers and treads of equal depth and a width all have yellow edging.



There is a handrail to the right at above the line of pitch. The handrail shape is circular

Lift

There is a lift for public use

The lift is located to left hand side of the reception area

The lift is a standard lift.

The floors which are accessible by this lift are level 1 to level 2

Staff do not need to be notified for use of the lift.

The clear door width is 995mm.

The dimensions of the lift are 1100mm x 1500mm

The lift does have a visual floor indicator.

The controls for the lift are 1100mm high from the floor.

The lighting level in the lift is medium.



Free Weight Suite

This is on level 2 of the facility Lighting is good





Fitness Suite

The fitness suite is located on level 3. Access to the fitness suite is via stairs, with a wheelchair platform.

All staff receives basic disability awareness training. Portable hearing loop is not available for induction. There is clear maneuvering space between equipment.

There is level access to all of the equipment.





Accessible Toilets

We have 1 accessible toilets and 1 accessible toilet/shower located on level 2.

There is pictorial signage on toilet doors.

There is level access to all accessible toilets.

Both facilities can be access by a radar key

Lights are activated automatically

Accessible Toilet

This is site to the left as you exit the lift

The width of the accessible toilet door is 900mm.

The door is light.

The dimensions of the accessible toilet are 1500mm wide and 2020mm depth

There is a dropdown rail on the transfer side

There is a mixer tap.

There an emergency pull cord alarms, one next to toilet.

The emergency pull cord alarm is fully functional.

Disposal facilities are available in the cubicle.

There is a/are female sanitary and non-infectious waste disposal units.

Accessible Toilet/Shower

This is located on level 2 leading to the fitness suite and free weight area.

Room size is 2700mm wide x 2400mm deep

Doors open inwards to the left and is 900mm wide

There are both fixed and dropdown support rails

Lights are activated automatically

There is an alarm cord, which is located near the WC and is from ceiling to floor

There is also an alarm cord to the left of the shower seat

All staff receives disability awareness / equality training. Documents can be requested in large print.

A bowl of water can be provided for an assistance dog.
